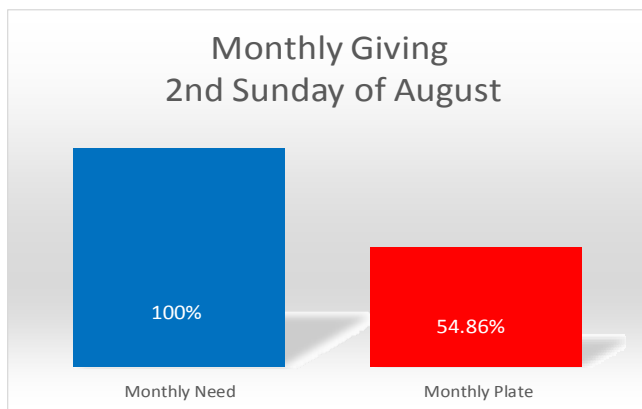

Six Superfoods That Can Help With Weight Loss

When the weather warms up, thoughts turn to trimming waistlines.

Here are a few effective weight-loss strategies: Reduce portion sizes, drink lots of water and eat plenty of fruits and vegetables. To maximize health and weight loss, try eating powerhouse foods that can accomplish both.

My top six are quinoa, chia seeds, cruciferous (green leaf) vegetables, (such as kale, cabbage, bok choy, broccoli, spinach, Brussel sprouts and cauliflower), berries such as blackberries, blueberries, cherries, goji berries, strawberries or cherries, beans including soybeans, black, pinto, kidney and white beans and finally mushrooms.

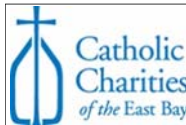
