It can also be given in a facility such as a nursing home or in the community, for example, or in an adult day care center.

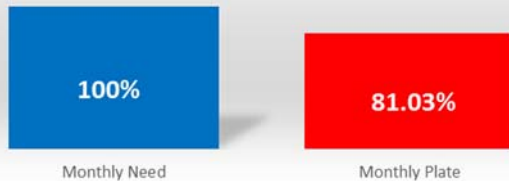
