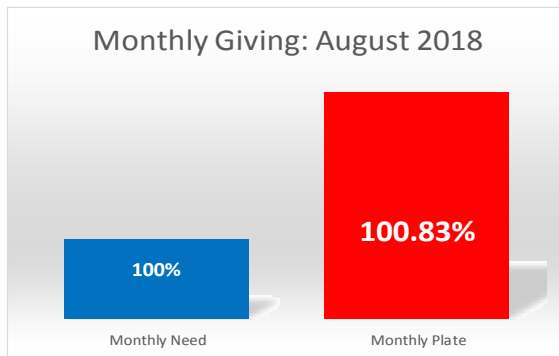

### *Nurses Notes*

#### FOOD AS MEDICINE TO PREVENT AND REVERSE DISEASE

Cancer prevention

Consuming 100 grams of red meat per day increases the risk of colorectal cancer by 17% and 50 grams of processed meat per day increases the risk by 18%. Approx 28 grams = 1 ounce

Rather, physicians should encourage patients to eat seven and a half servings of fruits and vegetables each day which is associated with a significant 14% reduction in total cancer risk.

Whole grains are also potent for reducing cancer risk, reducing colorectal cancer risk and total cancer mortality by 17%.

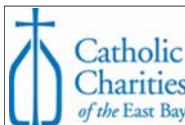
