Nurses Notes

Immunization for preteens

Doctors recommend that all pre-teens ages 11 and 12 get important shots (also called vaccines or immunizations) to protect against serious diseases.

What shots does my child need?

Meningococcal vaccine

This shot protects against types of meningococcal ("men-ing-gah-KAH-kul") disease, including meningitis ("men-in-JY-tis"). Meningitis is a very serious infection of the tissue around the brain and spinal cord.

HPV shots

These shots protect against human papillomavirus (HPV), which can cause several types of cancer. The HPV vaccine is given as a series of shots over several months, starting at age 11 or 12.

Tdap booster

This shot protects against tetanus ("TET-nes"), diphtheria ("dif-THEER-ee-ah"), and whooping cough (pertussis). It's a single shot that's given to pre-teens ages 11 or 12.

Yearly flu shot

Get the flu vaccine every year.

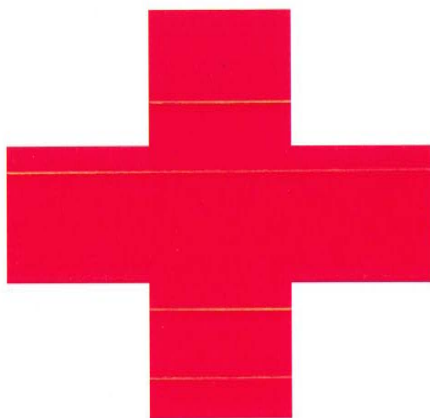
