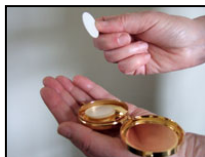

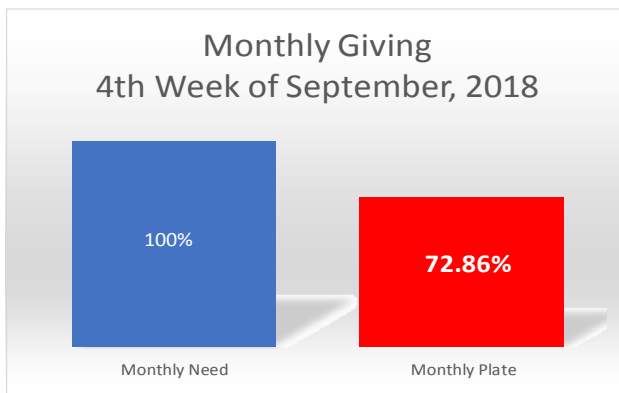

### *Nurses Notes*

With the school year at a start, it seems a good time to offer quick tips for parents on the topic of bullying. I will devote the next few weeks to this subject.

#### Tips on Preventing Bullying

Bullying is when a child tries to hurt another child physically or emotionally. Kids who bully use their power (like being popular or physically strong) to control or hurt others.

There are different kinds of bullying. Bullying can be:

- Physical – like hitting or pushing
- Verbal – like name-calling or teasing
- Social – like spreading rumors or leaving someone out on purpose

Bullying can be done in person, online, or with other technology (like cell phones). Bullying usually happens over and over again. Talk with your child about bullying – even if you don't see signs of a problem.

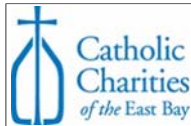
