A little way you can become more conscious of 'cause and effect' is to become more aware of the amount of plastic bottles/containers you have in your home. Ask yourselves as a family: How can we reduce our use of plastic? Do we recycle? Do we want to start recycling now?

Information: Enough plastic is thrown away each year to circle the Earth four times. Americans throw away **35 billion plastic bottles** every year. Only about **25%** of the plastic produced in the U.S. is recycled. If we recycled the other 75% we could save 1 billion gallons of oil and 44 million cubic yards of landfill space annually.

Get your Flu Shot

Flu vaccines have been updated to match circulating viruses. This year only injectable flu shots are recommended.

Getting your yearly flu shot is the best way to protect yourself and your family from getting the flu. You can reduce flu illnesses, doctor visits, missed work and school as well as hospitalizations.

With few exceptions the flu vaccine is recommended for everyone over age 6 months by the end of October. It is ok to get vaccinated later. It is especially important for those folks with chronic diseases like diabetes, asthma and heart disease and for those people age 65 years and older to get vaccinated.
