### October is breast cancer month

#### Breast Cancer Month Continues

Over the next few weeks I will discuss Risk factors of Breast cancer

#### What is a risk factor?:

- A risk factor is any thing that increases a person's chance of getting a disease.
- Different cancers have different risk factors Significantly High Risk
- If one has had cancer in one breast, the risk is 3-4 times as great for developing a new breast cancer.
- This can be unrelated to the first cancer or it can occur in another location or in the other breast.
- This is not the same as a recurrence of the previous cancer
