October is Breast Cancer Awareness Month

Breast Cancer Treatment

Over the past 20 years, progress in treatment and early detection has led to improved survival for people of all ages and races, and with all stages of breast cancer. Between 1990 and 2010, breast cancer mortality declined by 34 % among women in the U.S.

The goal of treating early breast cancer is to get rid of the cancer and keep it from coming back. Treatment of early breast cancer includes some combination of surgery, radiation therapy, chemotherapy, hormone therapy and targeted therapy.

Your breast cancer treatment plan is based on both medical and personal choices, it is tailored to:

- Your specific breast cancer (the biology of the tumor)
- The stage of the breast cancer
- Other medical issues
- Your personal preferences

Because of the differences between tumors and people, your treatment plan may differ from another person’s, even though you both have breast cancer. Each treatment option has risks and benefits to consider along with your own values and lifestyle.

Local Therapy- removes the cancer from a limited area, such as the breast, chest wall and lymph nodes in the underarm area (axillary nodes). It also helps to ensure the cancer does not come back to that area. It involves surgery, with or without radiation therapy to the breast area.
