Catholic Action Principles Avoid Negative People

You have one life to live. You want to be happy and to make your life meaningful. You haven't got time to waste with negative people. They will drain your energy. When they find a willing audience, they won't let it go. They may have justifiable concerns but too often get involved in minor matters. They blame and look for excuses. Even when blame can be justified, it serves no productive good. They are usually negative because they have ceded control of their happiness to others – the boss, the neighbors, the kids, the politicians, the police.

Be polite and encouraging to negative people. Suggest returning to Church. Suggest clerical counsel. Suggest good books. Suggest helping others. Always offer kind words. You can be compassionate, but still be strong enough to walk away. Everyone has problems, but not everyone allows those problems to rule them. You can offer a temporary safe haven without becoming a permanent home.

Nurses Notes

October is breast cancer month

Over the next few weeks I will discuss Risk factors of Breast cancer

Moderately higher risk

Getting older: Your risk for breast cancer increases as you age. Approximately 77% of women diagnosed with breast cancer are over the age of 50 and the other half are over age 65 or older. The risk of developing breast cancer is 1 in 68 women between age 40 and 49. In women 50-59 the risk increases to one in 37.

Direct family history: Having a mother, sister, or daughter (this is also called first degree relative) who has breast cancer puts you at greater risk for developing the disease. Even greater risk is if your relative developed breast cancer before menopause and had cancer in both breasts. By having a first degree relative with breast cancer it doubles a woman's risk, and having two first degree relatives increases her risk by 5 times. Interestingly enough having a male relative with breast cancer will also increase the woman's risk.

Genetics: BRCA1 or **BRCA2:** Carriers of alteration of these genes have up to an 80% chance of developing the breast cancer disease in their lifetime.

Breast lesions: A previous biopsy result of atypical hyperplasia (lobular or ductile) increases a woman's breast cancer risk by 4-5 times
