#### ITS TIME TO GET YOUR FLU SHOT

Last season was especially severe, with record-breaking levels of flu-like illness and hospitalizations.<sup>1</sup> Here's the good news: You can do your part to avoid serious illness and make this flu season easier on yourself and your loved ones, just by getting a flu shot.

It takes about 2 weeks after you get vaccinated for your body to develop the antibodies to protect you against the flu virus. That's why it's better to get vaccinated as soon as possible.

Who's at risk? 1) Children, especially school-aged children, are more likely to catch the flu then, Once infected, children can easily spread the flu to family members and friends. 2) People with compromised immune systems, such as chemotherapy patients or the elderly. So it's more important for those around them to get vaccinated since they may not be able to get vaccinated. 3) Pregnant women can protect their babies by getting the flu shot. The immunity you build will pass to your developing baby. 4) Everyone is at risk of getting the flu. Even healthy people get sick enough to miss significant time from work or school — or be hospitalized. So your entire family needs to get a flu shot every year.

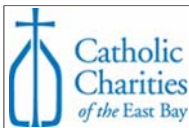

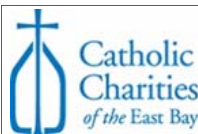
