Catholic Action Principles *Relax Your Body*

In your personal dealings, remain loose and light. Eliminate stress. There is rarely need to be tense and hardheaded. Much can be accomplished through calm reason and a soft voice.

Most physical movements should be loose, light, fluid, agile and flexible, rather than tense, hard, rigid and stiff. Slow, deep breathings will calm anxieties, lower your heart rate and allow for concentration. massages, steam baths, saunas and whirlpools also help the muscles to rest. Make sure you get your rejuvenating 6-8 hours of sleep per night.

If you feel stressed, count 1001, 1002, 1003 before you speak. At any time, start counting backwards from 100 as you breathe deeply. Let the air fill your belly as you inhale and exhale, more slowly and more fully with each breath. Quiet your muscles and relax.

Nurses Notes

October is breast cancer month

Over the next few weeks I will discuss Risk factors of Breast cancer

Slightly higher risk

Distant family history. Refers to breast cancer in more distant relatives such as aunts, grandmothers or cousins

Previous abnormal breast biopsy. Included are fibroadenomas, hyperplasia without atipia, sclerosing adenosis and solitary papilloma

Age at childbirth. Having your first child after age 35 or never having children puts you in this category.

Early menstruation. Risk increases if you got your period before age 12

Late menopause. Risk increases if you started menopause after age 55

Weight. Being over weight especially around the waist, increased fat intake, and increased caloric intake all put you in this category

Excessive radiation. This is especially true if you were given radiation for postpartum mastitis, or if you received prolonged fluoroscopic X-Rays for tuberculosis or if you were exposed to large amounts of radiation before age 30. (usually for treatment for cancer such as lymphomas

Other types of cancers. Family history of cancer of the ovaries, cervix, uterus or colon increases the risk

Heritage. Females of descendants of Eastern and Central European Jews are also at risk

Alcohol. Women who drink one alcoholic drink per day have a low risk. those women who consume 2-5 drinks day have a about 1 1/2 times the risk of women who drink no alcohol. Alcohol is also linked to cancer of the throat, mouth, esophagus

Race. Caucasian women have a slightly high risk of developing breast cancer than African-American, Asian, Hispanic, and Native Americans. the exception is that African American women are more likely to have breast cancer than caucasians under the age of 40 Hormone Replacement therapy. Long term use of combined estrogen and progesterone increases the risk of breast cancer. this risk seems to return to that of the general population after discontinuing them for 5 yrs or more.
