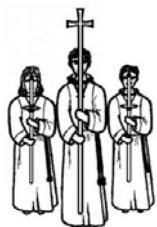

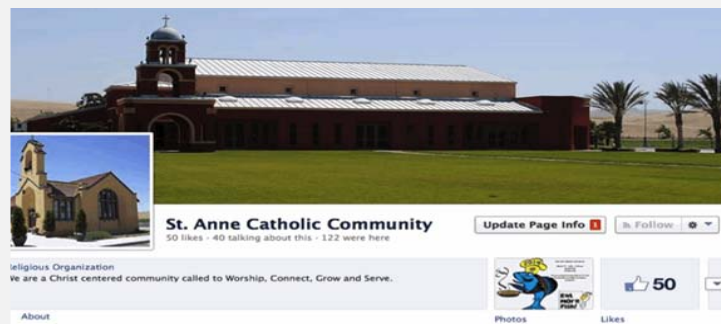

Flu Season is Around the Corner- Are you Ready

It's time to start protecting yourself and those you care for from the flu. Getting your annual flu shot is one of the best ways you can do this. You can't get the flu from the flu shot. Staying healthy during flu season means you won't miss out on the things you like to do.

Who should get the flu shot?

The flu shot is recommended for everyone 6 months of age and older. It is strongly recommended for:

- People at high risk for health complications (like pneumonia) if they get sick from the flu. They include:
 - Pregnant women
 - Children under age 5
 - People 65 years of age and older
- People of any age who have a chronic health condition like asthma, high blood pressure, or diabetes.
- People who can spread the flu to those at high risk. They include:
 - People who live with or take care of someone with a serious health condition.
 - People who live with or take care of a child under 6 months of age.

Who shouldn't get the flu shot?

- People who should not get the flu shot include:
- People who have had a bad reaction to flu shots in the past.
- People who have had Guillain-Barré syndrome (GBS)
- Children under 6 months of age.

Talk to your practitioner about getting the flu shot if you have an allergy to eggs or any ingredient in the vaccine.
