Nurses Notes:

November is Alzheimer's Disease Awareness month

Caregiving is a big issue for families with a loved one suffering from this disease.

There are stages the person with Alzheimer's goes through that we will explore.

"Early stage" refers to people, no matter what their age, who are diagnosed with Alzheimer's disease or related disorders and are in the beginning stages of the disease. A person in the early stages may experience mild changes in the ability to think and learn, but he or she continues to participate in daily activities and give-and-take dialogue. To others, the person may not appear to have dementia. The early stages of Alzheimer's can last for years.

YOUR ROLE AS A CAREGIVER

In the early stages, you may act more as a care partner, than a caregiver. Your role is one of support, love and companionship. You are there to help with daily life, as needed, and to help the person with Alzheimer's plan for the future. Since no two people experience Alzheimer's alike, the degree of assistance needed from a caregiver in this stage varies.

They may need help with:

- Keeping appointments
- Remembering words or names
- Recalling familiar places or people
- Managing money
- Keeping track of medications
- Doing familiar tasks
- Planning or organizing

The person will need emotional support. He or she may feel frustrated, anxious, embarrassed or isolated.

Encourage the person to share his or her feelings, and ask how you can be supportive.

Encourage the person to stay involved in activities he or she enjoys.

Make legal and financial care decisions for the future.
