## Nurses Notes

### November is Diabetes month

Over the next few weeks I will discuss what is Diabetes, Pre - Diabetes, Type 1 and Type 2 Diabetes and treatment.

#### Overview

Diabetes is the most common disorder of the endocrine (Hormone) system. It occurs when blood sugar levels in the body stay consistently above normal. It affects over 26 million people in the US alone.

Diabetes is a disease brought on by either the body's inability to make insulin (this is called Type 1 diabetes) or by the body not responding to the effects of insulin (Type 2 Diabetes). It can also appear during pregnancy. Insulin is one of the main hormones that regulates blood sugar levels and allows the body to use sugar (glucose) for energy. You should talk to your doctor about your risk for this disease

#### Prevention

Type 1 Diabetes can't be prevented but type 2 diabetes has modifiable risk factors that can lower your risk for developing the disease.

The types I will discuss re Pre - diabetes, Type 1 and 2 Diabetes, gestational diabetes and their treatments.

#### Pre - Diabetes

In the United States, 54 million people over the age of 20 have blood sugar levels that are higher than normal but not high enough to be called Diabetes. This is known as Pre- Diabetes, or impaired glucose tolerance. While people with pre- diabetes usually have no symptoms, it's almost always present before Diabetes occurs. However complications normally associated with this condition such as heart disease can begin to develop even when a person has only pre- diabetes.
