Nurses Notes:

November is Alzheimer's Disease Awareness month

The middle stages of Alzheimer's is typically the longest and can last for many years. As dementia progresses, the person with Alzheimer's will require a greater level of care. During this time, it is important for the caregiver to get the support needed.

During the middle stages of Alzheimer's, damage to the brain can make it difficult to express thoughts and perform routine tasks. Caregivers may notice the person with Alzheimer's jumbling words, having trouble dressing, getting frustrated or angry, or acting in unexpected ways, such as refusing to bathe.

Being a caregiver for someone in the middle stages of Alzheimer's requires flexibility and patience. As the abilities of the person with Alzheimer's change and functioning independently becomes more difficult, caregivers will need to take on more responsibility. As experience is gained, strategies are developed and ways of coping that work for the caregiver and the person with dementia.

As caregiving responsibilities become more demanding, it's important for the caregiver to take care himself. Take breaks, even if it is only for a few moments. Make sure not to isolate yourself. Learn what respite services are available in your community, and take friends and family up on offers to help. Since paying for long term care can be a big concern and source of stress, research all options if plans are not already in place.

Changes in behavior can be the most distressing for caregivers and family. During middle stages people may experience depression, anxiety, irritability and repetitive behaviors. As the disease progresses the person may have sleep disturbances, physical and verbal outbursts, and wandering.

As people with Alzheimer's gradually lose their ability to find words, express thoughts and follow conversations, they may have more difficulty understanding others. Communication changes during the middle stages include trouble finding the right word, repeating questions, losing the train of thought, reverting to a native language and relying on non-verbal communication.
