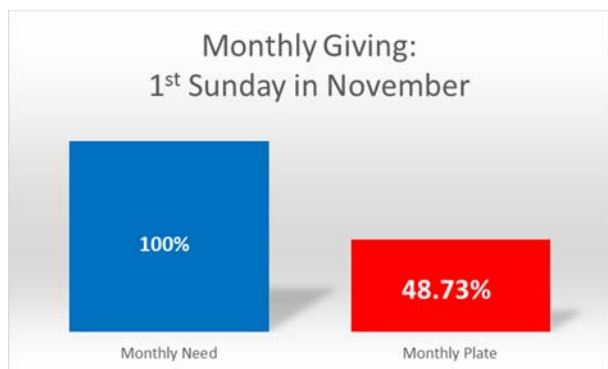

#### MEDICATION ADHERENCE

Helpful hits to stay on track

- 1 Contact your doctor or pharmacist and ask them how to take your medicine correctly. They can tell you how to manage your medications, including what to do if you miss a dose, whether you can take them with other drugs or vitamins, foods to avoid, and any possible side effects and interactions.
- 2 . Ask your doctor or pharmacist what you need to check and how often. For example, it may be important for you to know your blood pressure or blood sugar readings on a regular basis.
- 3 Use a reminder tool. Make it easier to keep track of your medicine schedule with a pill box, calendar, mobile phone, or medication tracker app. Create alarm reminders so you don't forget to take your doses.
- 4 Set up your routine. Get in the habit of taking your medicine at the same time each day, or during a daily activity such as eating breakfast or dinner.
- 5 Keep your eye on the bottle. Place your medicines where you can see them every day, like your kitchen counter or nightstand — as long as it's a cool, dry place away from children and pets.
- 6 Ask family or friends to remind you to take your medication and to refill them on time.

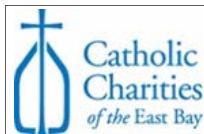
