Nurses Notes

Sugar Sweetened Beverages and Type 2 Diabetes

Liquid sugar is a unique driver of today's skyrocketing type 2 diabetes and obesity epidemics. Diabetes rates have almost tripled over the past three decades, just as sugary beverage consumption has doubled. At the same time, the rates of obesity (a major risk factor for diabetes) more than doubled for adults, tripled for adolescents and quadrupled for 6-11 year old children.

A growing body of research shows that sugary beverages – because they provide all of their calories from sugar in liquid form – are uniquely harmful. Spikes in blood sugar can overwhelm the body and lead to the transformation of sugar into fat in the liver, which contributes directly to the development of type 2 diabetes.

Studies have found:

- Drinking one or two sugary drinks a day increases the risk of developing type 2 diabetes by 26 percent.
- After six months, daily consumption of sugary drinks increases fat deposits in the liver by 150 percent, leading directly to both type 2 diabetes and heart disease.
- Sugary drink consumption is especially high in undiagnosed diabetic populations. Undiagnosed diabetics consumed significantly more (60% versus 38% of people with diagnosed but uncontrolled diabetes).
