## **November is Alzheimer's Disease Awareness month**

### **Alzheimer's Middle Stage caregiving**

Eating, dressing and grooming will become more challenging as dementia progresses. This loss of independence and privacy can be a difficult transition for the person with dementia. Patience and sensitivity will go a long way to help in helping him or her through it. Once assistance is needed to complete daily tasks, think about the person's abilities. Encourage the person to do as much as possible, being ready to help when needed. For example, when dressing, you can give direction indirectly by laying out clothing in the order in which the item is put on.

In addition to enhancing quality of life, activities can reduce behaviors like wandering and agitation. You don't need to invent new things to do. Think of activities as things we do as part of our daily living. Activities can be making dinner together, gardening, listening to music or going for a walk.

Driving- During the middle stages of the disease, a person with Alzheimer's will need to stop driving. When it is clear that driving is no longer safe, try to involve the person with dementia in the decision to stop. Explain your concerns by giving specific examples. Assure the person you will do everything possible to make rides available.

Early in the middle stages, it will become too difficult or dangerous for a person with Alzheimer's to be left alone. Safety precautions will need to be taken throughout the living environment. At this point, if the person is living alone, he or she may need to move in with relatives or to a residential care setting.

This is the time when the caregiver needs to hook up with a social worker that has knowledge of care facilities and the process which is needed to move the person to an appropriate facility.
