In honor of World Diabetes Day

#### **Is there a difference between sugar and high fructose corn syrup?**

There are over 60 different names for sugar added to foods, including cane sugar, corn syrup, high fructose corn syrup, brown sugar and more.

However, whether it is table sugar or high fructose corn syrup, they break down into glucose and fructose in almost equal ratios. **The big problem is fructose.**

**Too much fructose leads to fatty liver disease, increases cardiovascular risk and causes inflammation.**

When people **over eat** added sugars, it means they are consuming too much fructose. **The liver utilizes needed fructose for energy and the rest is converted to fat.** Up to 70% of people with diabetes have fatty liver disease.

#### **Q. Is fruit bad for us?**

**A. No, since it contains relatively low amounts of fructose.**
