Nurses Notes

November is Diabetes month

Over the next few weeks I will discuss what is Diabetes, Pre - Diabetes, Type 1 and Type 2 Diabetes and treatment.

Type 2 diabetes

Symptoms of type 2 diabetes due to high blood sugar may include:

- Increased thirst
- increased hunger (especially after eating) dry mouth
- frequent urination
- unexplained weight loss (even though you are eating and feel hungry)
- fatigue (weak and tired feeling)
- blurred vision
- headaches
- loss of consciousness

Contact your health provider if you have any of these symptoms or if you have questions. It's important to get diabetes testing and start a treatment plan early. Type 2 diabetes is usually not diagnosed until health complications have occurred. Most often, there are no diabetes symptoms or a very gradual development of the above symptoms of type 2 diabetes. In fact, about a third of all people who have type 2 diabetes don't know they have it. Other symptoms of type 2 diabetes may include:

- slow healing sores or cuts
- itching of the skin (usually around the vaginal or groin area)
- frequent yeast infections
- recent weight gain
- velvety dark skin changes of the neck, armpit, and groin, called acanthosis nigricans
- numbness and tingling of the hands and feet
- decreased vision
