## Gratitude

Studies have shown that gratitude is linked to well being. A group of studies suggests that people who practice gratitude appear to be more optimistic, feel good about life, and are more resilient.

Saying "thanks" and appreciating what's important to you are part of being grateful.

At the end of each day or each week, think about, or write down, what you are grateful for, about people, events, or experiences that have had a positive impact on you.

Call or email someone just to say "thanks." write a letter of gratitude and appreciation to someone.

Just say "thank you" to people you don't know, such as waving when a person lets your car cut in during heavy traffic.

If feeling burdened by your health, give thanks for the abilities you still have.

Giving thanks before a meal, what a nice family ritual!
