People love to be involved in projects which they helped design. Help others to identify and develop their strengths. Be quick to praise and slow to criticize. Look for opportunities to teach others about the Catholic faith.

Nurses Notes

7 principles of good care for diabetes

Take good care of your diabetes for life and be sure to follow these 7 principles

Principle 1 - learn as much as you can about diabetes attend classes or make an appointment to see a certified diabetes educator

Principle 2 - get regular care for your diabetes get regular checkups and regular blood tests

Principle 3 - Learn how to control your diabetes attend classes or make an appointment with a certified diabetes educator

Principle 4 - take care of your A B C's

Know your aic, and keep it less than 7.0, keep your blood pressure under control, ask your doctor what is good for you, and keep your cholesterol under control.

Principle 5 - monitor your ABC's

Keep these values under god control

Principle 6 - prevent long term complications have your eyes examined by a ophthalmologist, have your kidneys checked by doing lab work, get your aic done 2 times a year or more if necessary, have your blood pressure checked 2 times a year or more if necessary, have your cholesterol done 2 times a year or more, and keep this under good control.

Principle 7 - get checked for long term problems and treat them.
